Message Control and Choreography: Phase 2

Documentation of MCC Phase 1 is complete. The sub-team profiles specifying how to support choreographies of one-action PIPs over the ebMS, AS2, WS-I, and RNIF protocols are posted on the website and available to everyone.

In addition, the team is planning the Phase 1 validation certifying that the exchange can be done between Solution Providers and confirming the business collaboration between the supply chain partners.


We expect them to take a leadership role in promoting RosettaNet implementation.
